



Ivan Cawson sold hardware at the first department thro' the door on the left from age 14 to his fifties. Hastings and Wilfred Hill were the owners. Miss White sold jewellery, handbag etc on the opposite side, with Mr Browne from Port Stewart upstairs. The huge basement was pumped full of concrete when Boots bought the premises. Next door was an undertakers (Galbraith?)
