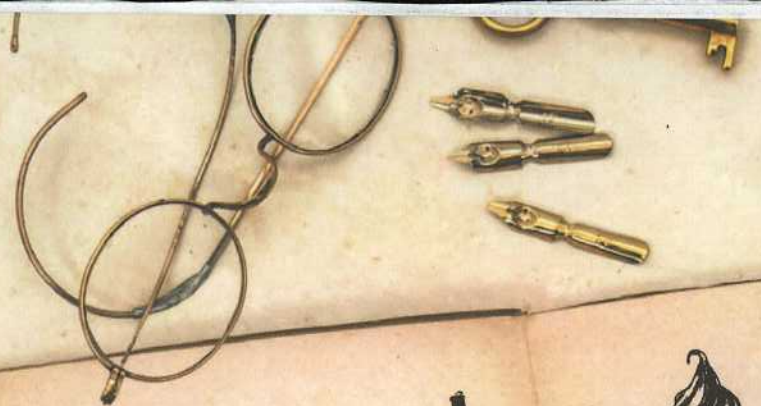

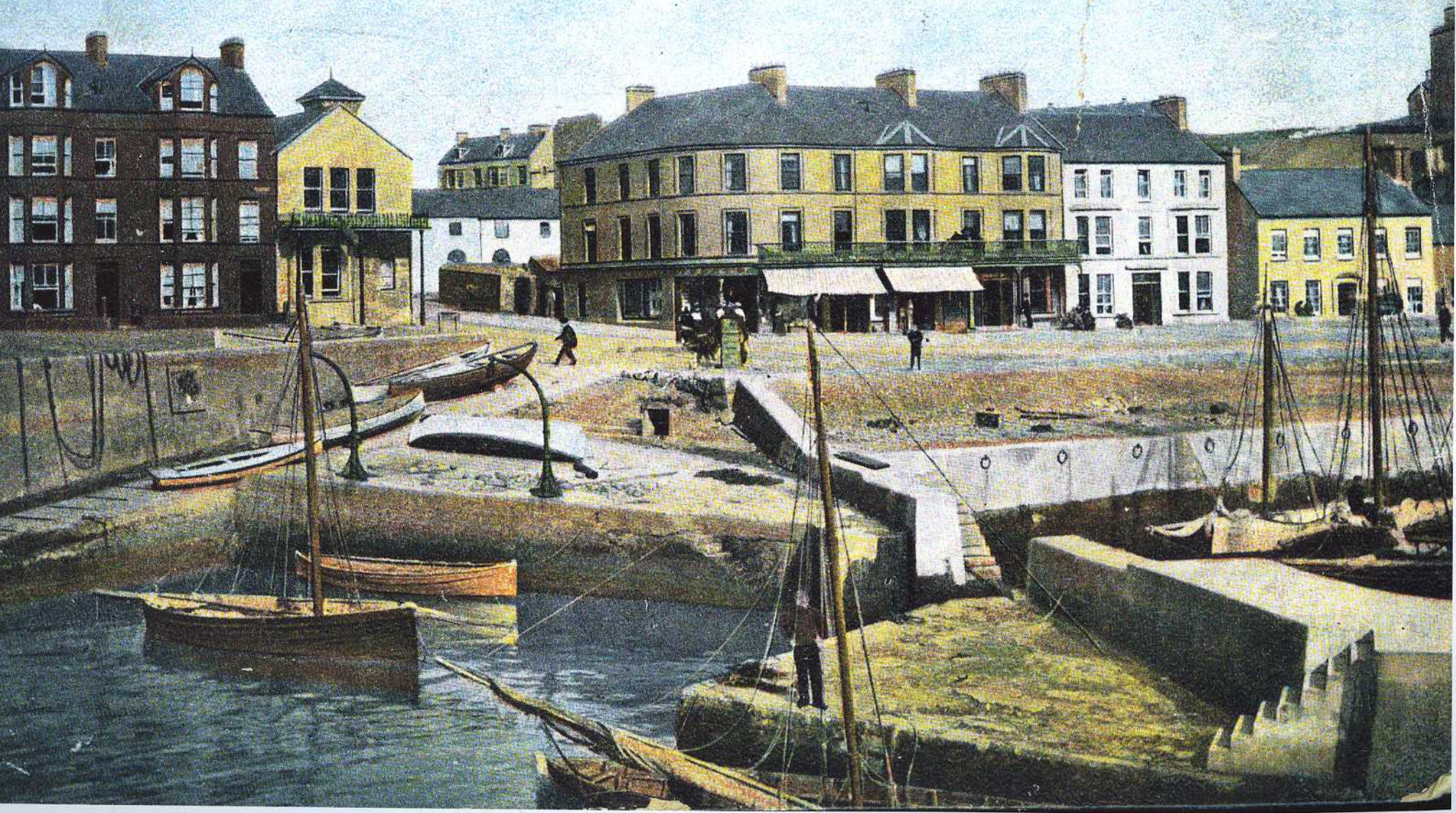

23/7/16	Seaghe Taylor John Taylor	Passing through on a trip out from Carrerock great exhibition well done.

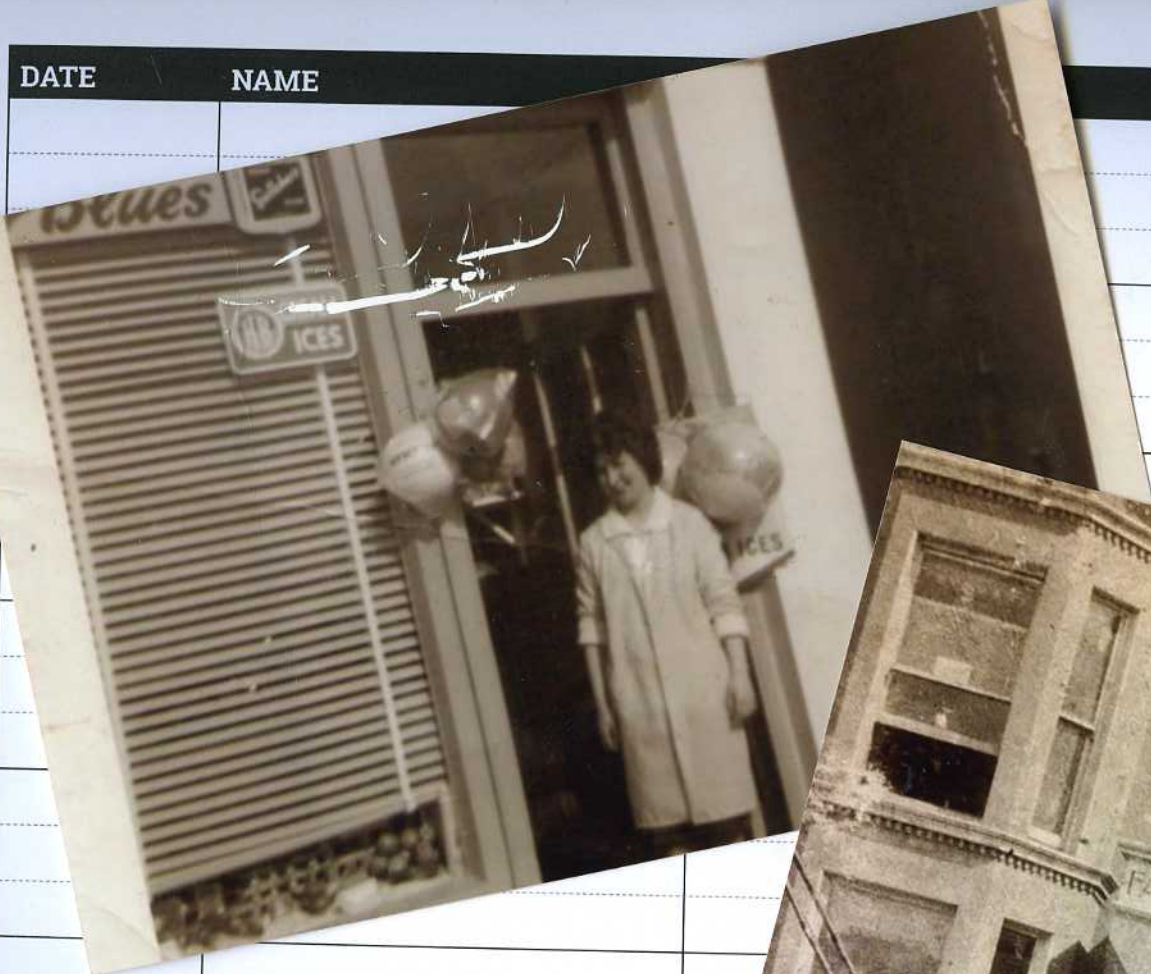
