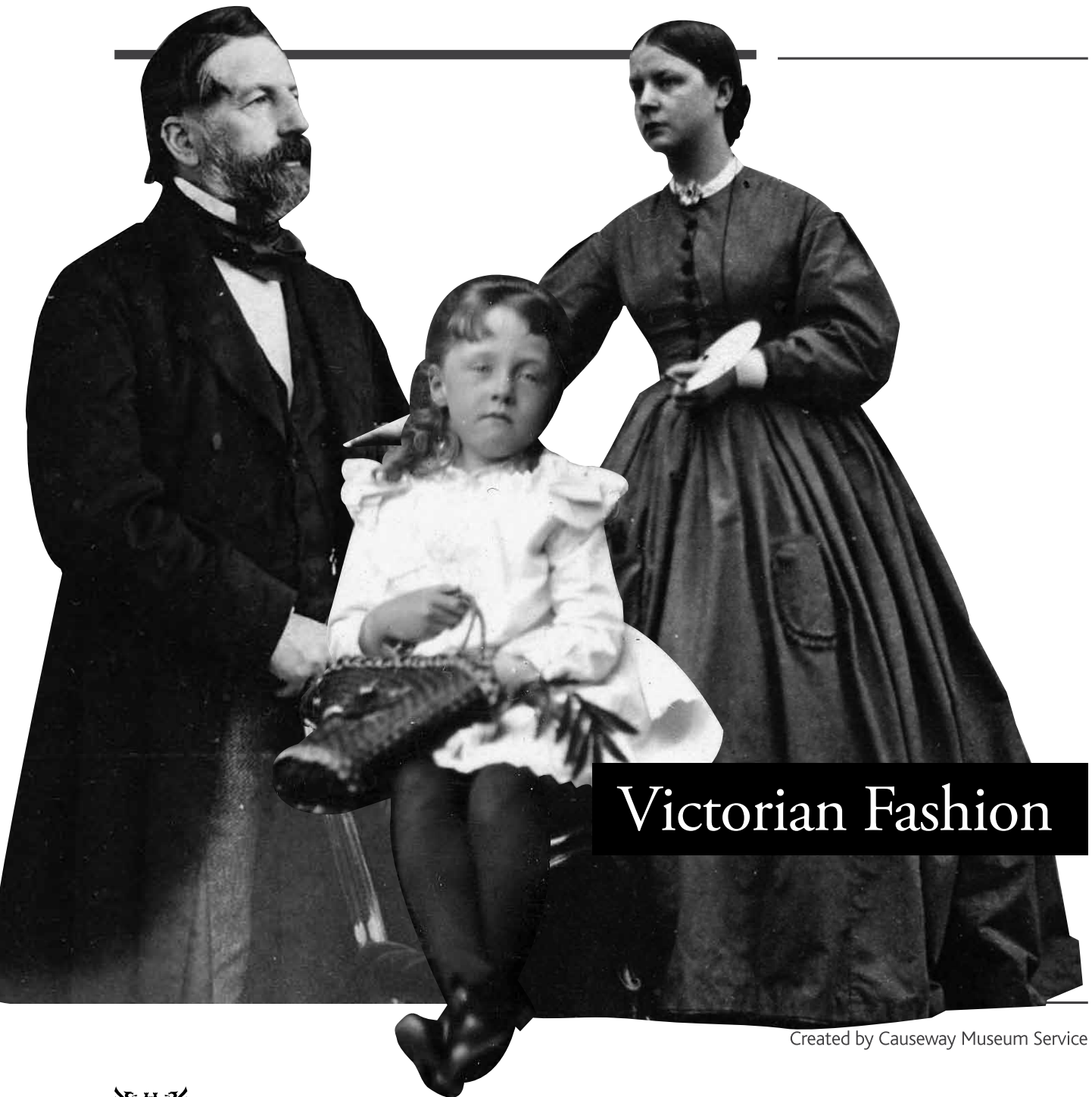

Victorian Fashion

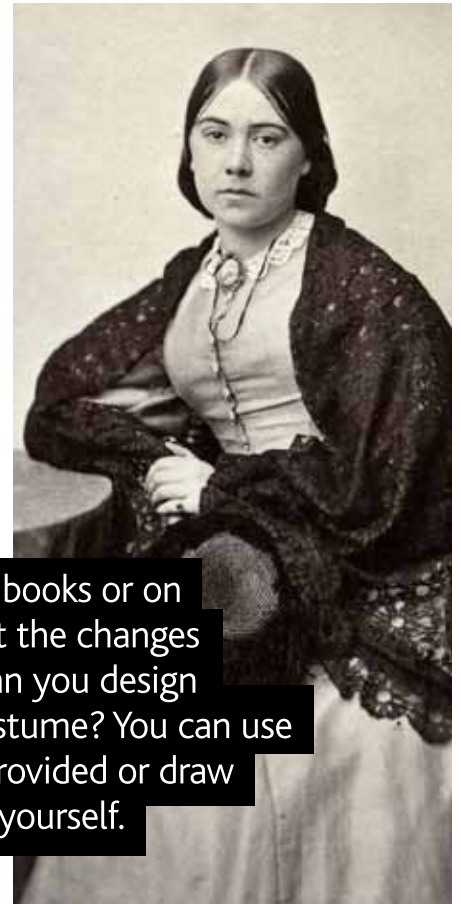

Can you help him out?

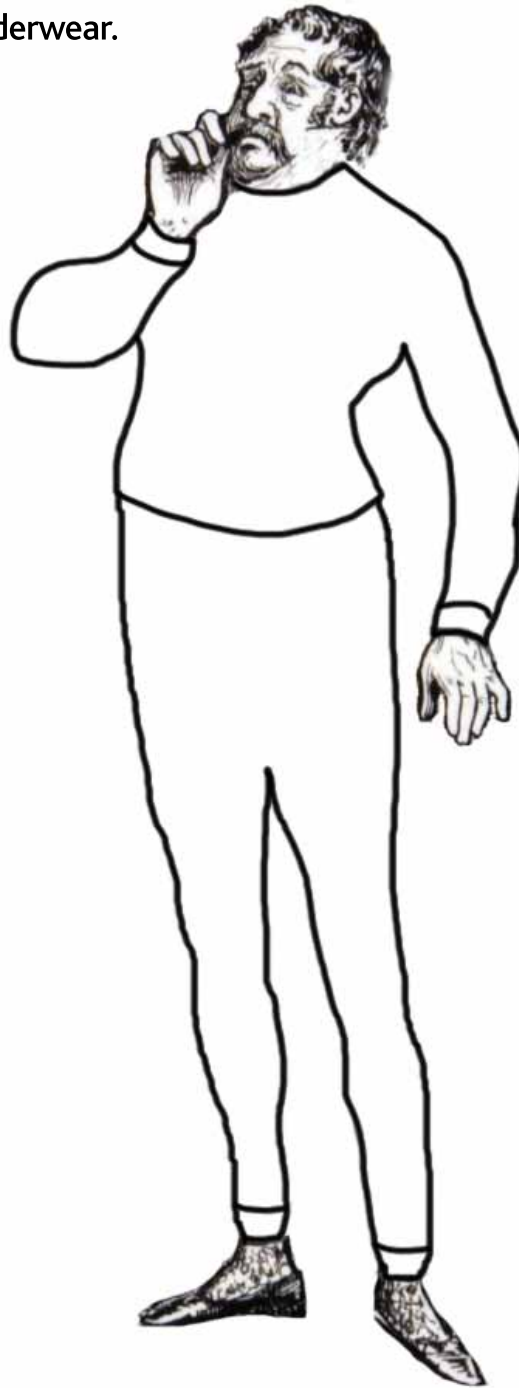
