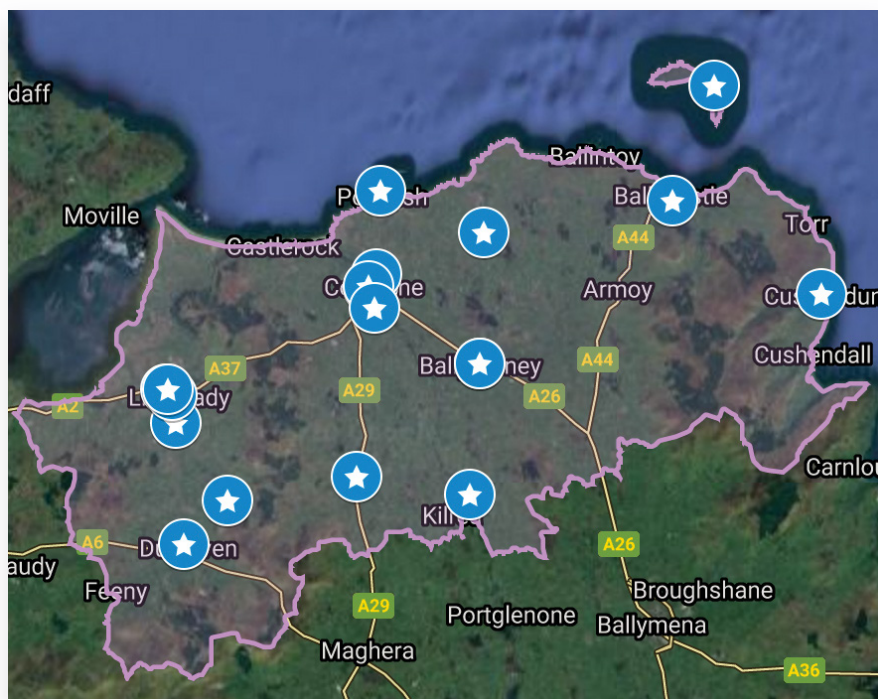
To avoid disappointment make sure to plan any visits/outings and make any necessary appointments in advance of your visit.
