In 1948 Miss Shearmon saw the need for a centre for the women of the district to meet for special and educational activities and soon after a Women's Institute came into being. The Formation meeting was held in the school on November 11th 1948.

From a committee of 10, the office leaders were as follows: President Miss R. S. Shearmon, Vice President Miss Mooney. The Secretary was Miss Morrison and the Treasurer was Mrs M. McCaughey. Membership for the first few years numbered at 20 but over the years almost doubled. The activities of the institute have been many with varied craft work being the most popular of pursuits. The institute like others has been a great help and benefit to the local community.
